

Squash and Racquetball

For the fit and energetic there are three Squash & Racquetball Association (SRA) standard courts.

Squash has been played at the club since the 70's and over the years the club has had many notable team as well as individual successes, and at its peak had well in excess of 200 members. Unfortunately in recent years as with squash in general there has been a significant decline in the number of members playing squash, this has been partial countered by the recent introduction of racquetball which has encouraged some members who were considering giving up squash to continue a new playing career.

There is no fixed club night for squash or racquetball but many of the members get together on a Saturday afternoon from about 3.00pm to have a "friendly" game, and then follow this with a discussion on the merits of the each match in the bar afterwards. But friendly games can always be arranged with another member, contact telephone numbers can be found on the squash notice board in the club foyer.

The squash section was unable to find enough members of team standard to enter the local leagues for the last winter season, however with the influx of only a few new members it would be possible to once again have a team entered. So if you are an experienced squash player looking for league standard squash then come on down to Hartley Country Club. As racquetball has only just started being played at the club no teams have yet been entered in the local league, but there is always a possibility that this could change if enough interest is shown by members.
